Once all of the above items have been completed, you will be assigned the next available parking spot.

Online Student Breakfast & Lunch Opportunity

Breakfasts and lunches will be available to all online students during each school week. These meals are FREE to all students. For the first week of school, meals can be picked up from 3:30 to 4:30 every day at DHS. After the first week of school, meals can be picked up every Wednesday.

Student Support & Tutoring

DHS is offering student help time every school day, Monday through Friday, from 2:11pm to 2:41pm. During this help time, DHS teachers will be supporting and tutoring our students in either Google Meet/Zoom meeting, or in a face to face meeting. Please contact your teacher(s) for support or tutoring.

Did you know?

Starting this fall, Davison High School will be a 1:1 school, meaning that each student will be assigned a Chromebook for their online and face to face course work. Our online courses will be designed to be asynchronized, however, it is the expectation that students will sign in every school day to complete at least one hour of learning for each of their online classes they are assigned. It is highly recommended that students start their first online class at 8:30am each day but it is not required.

And....

Regardless of face to face or online, all classes will have Google Classroom as the learning management system. Students will have a Google Classroom code/website assigned to them for every class they are scheduled for at DHS. PARENTS can ask the teacher or their student for the Google Classroom code so they can see the assignments, assessments, and the learning resources our teachers are preparing and presenting to our students.





ATTENTION ALL STUDENTS

WHO PARK ON CAMPUS!!

PLEASE make sure you are parking in the parking spot which has been assigned to you!

DRESS CODE REMINDERS

Please refer to the 2020-2021 Parent Student Handbook, Administrative Policies, page 17 –18, for all Dress Code policies. This is a reminder of a few of the following inappropriate apparel:

- ◆ Jeans/slacks **MUST NOT** have holes that expose skin in areas more than 7" above the crease behind the knee.
- ◆ Shirts/tops/dresses showing midriff or are cut too low.
- ◆ Hats, bandanas, hoods or headgear (including headbands & sunglasses) must be removed upon entering the building.
- ◆ Sleeveless shirts/tops/dresses without collars or crew necks (shoulder straps less than 2 inches in width.)
- ◆ Shorts, skirts, and dresses more than 7" above the crease behind the knee.
