Our District continues to work toward fulfilling Board of Education goals. In December 2023, the Board approved updated Goal recommendations. While there are no changes to the three goal areas—Instructional, Resources and School Climate—administrators did propose new strategies, action steps and monitoring tools that will align the goals with the Michigan Integrated Continuous Improvement Process. MICIP is a targeted approach and pathway used by districts to improve student outcomes by assessing whole child needs to develop plans and coordinate funds. The updated goals are as follows:

Status of the School Improvement Plan

The Michigan Department of Education directed all school districts to transition to the new continuous improvement process referred to as the Michigan Integrated Continuous Improvement Process (MICIP) by January 2021.

At Davison Community Schools, we have a District MICIP Team composed of representatives from each school building to include a variety of perspectives and ideas. The team uses district- and building-level data to identify areas of need in order to create a continuous improvement plan using evidence-based strategies and activities. It is the role of the District to support the instruction at the systems level as well as to fund the plan.

The MICIP Team has identified two goals:

- Improve Social Emotional Learning (SEL) capacity by focusing on Multi-Tiered Systems of Support (MTSS) behavior.
- Provide cohesive curriculum, instruction, assessment and intervention.

Both are active goals that are being implemented and monitored in all school buildings and throughout the District.

Process for Assigning Pupils to School

The District is a "schools of choice" district in that there are no set school building boundaries within the district. Any child living within Davison school boundaries can attend any school within the district at the student's grade level. Davison Community Schools also participates in the state of Michigan's 105 and 105c Schools of Choice programs, which provides students living outside district boundaries opportunities to attend Davison.

A brief description of each specialized school:

All of our school buildings offer a quality education and are unique in their own ways.

- Davison High School: Houses approximately 1,600 students in grades 9-12.
- Davison Alternative High School: Specializes in credit recovery for students in grades 9-12.
- Davison Middle School: Houses seventh and eighth graders.
- Hahn Intermediate School: Houses fifth and sixth graders
- Central Elementary: First through fourth graders and the district's gifted and talented program
- Gates Elementary—Houses first through fourth graders and
- Hill Elementary—Houses Kindergarten through fourth graders
- Siple Elementary—Houses Kindergarten through fourth grades and cognitively impaired
- Thomson Elementary

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Postsecondary Enrollment Options

Each year, students at Davison High School have the opportunity to enroll in Advanced Placement classes or Postsecondary courses at local colleges or universities. During the 2022-23 school year:

- Davison High School had **7** students enrolled in postsecondary courses, which totaled **16** college classes.
- Davison High School offered 15 Advanced Placement/College Level Equivalent courses to students in the Davison Community Schools. All classes were offered at DHS.
- Davison High School had 217 students enrolled in AP/College Level Equivalent courses at DHS.
- 151 DHS students took 251 AP tests, which can result in college credit for courses taken. Tests
 were in Chemistry, Computer Programming, English Language, English Literature, Government,
 U.S. History, Comparative Government and Politics, Psychology, Macroeconomics, Microeconomics, Biology, Statistics, Calculus AB, Calculus BC and Spanish.
- There were 148 students enrolled in the Davison Early College Program, which totaled 743 courses.

Staff Development

Davison Schools budgets for and provides opportunities for staff to attend in-district and out-of-district professional development experiences, and offered training in 2022-23 for staff in the following:

- The District provided 30 hours of PD on various topics such as SEL competencies, curriculum development, formative assessment, school improvement, school safety, and learning strategies.
- Counselors and music teachers attended annual conferences.
- Elementary principals attended the annual Michigan Elementary and Middle School Principals conference.

Core Curriculum

The State of Michigan requires that all students enrolled in public school districts receive daily core curriculum instruction in language arts, reading, English, math, science and social studies. Davison Community Schools, being in full compliance with state requirements, offers daily core curriculum instruction which meets or exceeds state requirements in all areas. The district has developed and implemented outcomes for kindergarten through 12th grades which reflect the state Core Curriculum guidelines. The content of these guidelines is based on ". . .an effective program which fosters the development of a well-rounded literate individual."

The Advisory Curriculum Council, an ongoing group made up of board members, teachers, and administrators reviews each of the core areas on a six- to eight-year cycle. Additionally, student achievement is monitored in each of the five core academic areas by standardized achievement tests, teacher developed tests and MEAP test results.

For the 2022-23 school year, the District spent \$600,000 in textbook and curriculum resources as recommended by the District's Advisory Curriculum Committee. Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) III funds set aside to address learning loss paid for nearly half of the costs and were used to purchase English Language Arts curriculum for elementary students.

Other subjects that were addressed included: art for grades seven -12, English for grades nine -12, Math for Developmental Kindergarten through fourth grade, Music for grades seven through 12, Physical Education/Health for grades seven and eight, Physical Education for Grades Developmental Kindergarten through fourth grade and grades nine through 12, Science for grades Developmental Kindergarten through eighth grade, World History and AP Government for grades nine through 12.

- Graduation rate (4-year-cohort) of 90 percent

Goal 2: Davison community schools will uphold the highest standards of operational reliability, financial integrity and transparency while simultaneously striving to maximize the district's resources to their fullest to guarantee the fiscal stability and long-term sustainability of our district.

The goal measures would include:

- Fund equity in the General Fund will remain at or above 12 percent.
- Ensure a minimum annual completion rate of 70 percent for identified 10-year plan projects funded through site sinking fund revenue.
- Plan, implement, monitor and evaluate strategies to uphold the safety and security of schools.
- Sustain and maintain the District's investment in technology.
- Continue maintenance, upkeep and replacement of transportation fleet.
- The District will be fully staffed.

Goal 3: Davison community schools will increase student engagement and positive behavior as a result of staff receiving sustained and ongoing support in the areas of social-emotional learning, student engagement and positive behavior training.

Goal measures would include:

- Decrease in student referrals
- Increase in District WSCC (Whole School, Whole Community, Whole Child) survey results
- Increase in Whole Child Survey Indicators Survey
- Increase in District's Tenets Survey
- Increase in student academic achievement
