As you are aware, Governor Whitmer extended the stay-at-home order through Thursday, May 28, so that means we need to adjust the curbside pickup times that we communicated last week for Davison High School seniors.

**June 9, 2020, Seniors with the last name starting with:**

**A - B, 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM**

**C - E, 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM**

**F - H, 11:00 AM to 12:00 PM**

**I - L, 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM**

**A - L, Make up time - 2:00 PM to 3:00 PM**

**June 10, 2020, Seniors with the last name starting with:**

**M - N, 9:00 AM to 10:00 AM**

**O - R, 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM**

**S - T, 11:00 AM to 12:00 PM**

**U - Z, 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM**

**A - Z, Make up time - 2:00 PM to 3:00 PM**

In order to keep our students and staff safe, students will be asked to wear a mask, gloves and observe social distancing guidelines in keeping six feet away from others. For everyone's safety, we require that students do not congregate or gather on the campus. For the curbside pick/ drop off, drivers will be directed to enter and exit the High School's campus from Lapeer Road onto Alger Drive. Students will remain in their vehicles, and participate in a parade route with station stops for items such as diplomas, cap and gown, yearbooks, Jostens orders, cords for honors, community service, etc. Also, students will drop off textbooks, library books, school electronics, athletic equipment, band uniforms, pay fines and return all other school property. As the last parade station stop, students needing to enter the building for personal items will have about a 15-minute window to pick up their items and clean out their locker.
