- Arrange with the teacher for a possible 'virtual' guest to read to the class in honor of your child's birthday
- Ask the teacher to take the students outside for an extra recess in honor of your child's birthday
- Send in something that all the kids can sign, like a large card, sweatshirt, pillowcase, etc. as a special treat for your child
- Have your child bring in something special for show and tell on their birthday
