Government: Please be sure to study the blue vocabulary cards located in the front cover of the homework folder. Students have now learned about common good, patriotism, popular sovereignty, equality, and justice.

Homework: Pink math homework sheets are sent home almost each day. These sheets are review sheets based on the math we covered that day. Math homework is due back the next school day. Pink sheets should not take very long to complete. Students who do not complete and return these sheets will have their Cardinal Code grade for Dependable reflect this.

Subtraction: Even though we have moved into multiplication and division, our math program spirals back to addition and subtraction as well. Some students are finding it challenging to go back and forth between operations and remembering what to do. When practicing at home, a good idea would be to practice all 4 operations. (+, -, x, and +) Examples would include: 355-126, 459+34, etc.

### Math Tip of the Week: Geometry Shapes!

Take your child on a shape scavenger hunt with a digital camera and a list of shapes to find. Challenge them to find as many different geometric shapes that they know. While exploring, talk to them about shapes they might not yet know. The uses of parallel lines in architecture or symmetry in nature are just some examples. Make a pizza with your child. Discuss the fractions in the recipe. Cut the pizza in halves, fourths, eighths, and sixteenths.

Typing Skills: In the spring, students will take the M-Step electronically. They will be expected to type in their answers. We have been practicing typing at school when possible. Students struggle still to use home row keys and are typing very slowly. Do they know how to type upper case letters? Can they add punctuation? How do you move down lines?
