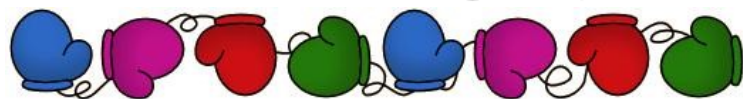




Frosty Learning FUN!

COMPLETE SENTENCES: We have been talking in class about making sure we are writing in complete sentences. This is something students should be doing on any of their written work. Please stress to your child the importance of writing complete sentences.
